Any United States citizen 18 years of age or older or who will be 18 prior to the next election) and not a felon* can register to vote. You must re-register if you have:

1. Legally changed your name (by marriage or otherwise.)
2. Changed your residence.
3. Changed your party affiliation.
4. *Completed a felony sentence.

You may register online, or obtain voter registration applications from the Santa Fe County Bureau of Elections, (505) 986-6280, and you may register in person at the County Clerk's Office, the NM Motor Vehicle departments, and most public libraries. Register, check your voter status, or make changes at <http://www.sos.state.nm.us/>

Primary elections are held on the first Tuesday in June of even-numbered years and are open to registered members of the major parties. All other elections are open to registered voters regardless of party affiliation or independent status.
