**1. REGISTER TO VOTE or CONFIRM YOUR REGISTRATION**

- NOW:** **Confirm your registration.** [nmvote.org](http://nmvote.org)  
Go to: Voter Information Portal – Find my Registration & Voter Info.
- Oct 6:** Community Voter Registration ended.
- Oct 7-30:** Register and Vote in person same day.  
**Register:** County Clerk’s Office (100 Catron St.) Photo ID required  
**Vote:** Across the street at Convention Center (2012 W. Marcy St.)  
8:00 am to 5:00 pm (Mon thru Fri)
- Oct 31 only:** Same as above.

**2. REQUEST ABSENTEE BALLOT – ONLINE, BY MAIL, BY PHONE**

- NOW – Oct 20:** **Paper application** can be printed out now, and dropped off at County Clerk’s office, or mailed to County Clerk PO Box. (SEE ABOVE)

**Important to mail ASAP.**  
OR request an application by calling the County Clerk. 505-986-6280
- NOW – OCT 20:** **Online application** request at [nmvote.org](http://nmvote.org).  
Go to: Voter Information Portal – Find my Registration & Voter Info  
**\*\*Online application is fastest and most efficient way to apply.\*\***
- Sep 14:** County Clerk mailed a paper application to every registered voter.  
Drop off or mail your application now.
- Oct 6:** Absentee ballots will be mailed to all voters who successfully applied. Allow plenty of time to receive and return ballot. Drop off boxes are more efficient than mail.

**Make sure your application matches your voter registration info exactly, or it will be denied.**

**NOTE:**

**If you already requested an absentee ballot and instead want to vote in person, you must tell the poll worker, and then sign an affidavit that you have not and will not use the absentee ballot.**

### 3. EARLY VOTING AT CONVENTION CENTER

**Oct 6-31:** Santa Fe Community Convention Center - 201 W. Marcy St.  
8:00AM to 5:00PM (Mon thru Fri)

**BEST CHOICE: DROP OFF BOX AVAILABLE AT COUNTY CLERK AND CONVENTION CENTER, OR VOTE IN PERSON AT THE CONVENTION CENTER (201 W. Marcy St.)**

**Oct 12:** No voting in observance of Indigenous People's Day

**Oct 31 only:** In-Person Voting at Convention Center. No other Saturdays.
