1. REGISTER TO VOTE or CONFIRM REGISTRATION

2. ABSENTEE BALLOT: APPLICATION

For this election, applications cannot be mailed without a request.

BEST CHOICE: ONLINE APPLICATION IS FASTEST AND MOST EFFICIENT WAY TO APPLY

NOW – Oct 20: **Online application** request at nmvote.org.
Go to: Voter Information Portal – Find my Registration & Election Info

Paper application. Available at County Clerk (100 Catron), or call County Clerk at 505-986-6280 to request an application.

DEADLINE: Submit to County Clerk ASAP, but before October 20 is recommended.

In person: Drop boxes at locations in #6, or County Clerk during business hours.

Mail: To arrive before October 20.

*Check nmvote.org to make sure **your application** exactly matches your voter registration info, for timely processing.*

3. ABSENTEE BALLOT: RETURN

Oct 5: Absentee ballots will begin to be mailed to voters who successfully apply.

BEST CHOICE: DROP OFF BOXES ARE BEST, or MAIL TO BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN NOV 2, 7:00PM

Check nmvote.org to make sure the name and signature on the outside envelope exactly matches your voter registration.

4. AT COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE: ABSENTEE or SAME-DAY REGISTRATION AND EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING

8:00AM to 5:00PM (Mon thru Fri)

Closed Oct 11 for Indigenous Peoples Day

Oct 30 ONLY: Same-Day Registration and Early Voting
at County Clerk's Office.
10:00AM-6:00PM

5. AT ALTERNATE EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS: ABSENTEE or SAME-DAY REGISTRATION AND EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING

**BEST CHOICE: DROP OFF BOXES INSIDE ALL LOCATIONS, OR
SAME-DAY REGISTRATION AND IN-PERSON VOTING**
